This Parent Obligations form must be completed and signed by parents or guardians at the time of registration for the athlete's registration to be accepted.

Parent and guardian participation is essential for the Centre to operate successfully.

Parents and guardians are expected to assist at the Centre competition each fortnight as an official or helper at events, or in the canteen or barbecue. Everyone can help in some way. For instance, timing or place judging at a track event, measuring a distance at a field event, replacing the high jump bar after a jump, raking the sand pit for the long jump, writing times or distances on recording sheets, or assisting with data entry in the computer room.

In addition, equipment needs to be set up prior to, and put away following competition and parents and guardians are expected to assist in this when called to do so, normally 3 or possibly 4 times during the season, scheduled by age group.

Importantly, parents and guardians are responsible for their children and must be in attendance at all times during Centre competitions.

By signing this form, you are confirming that you understand and agree that:

1. You are responsible for your children and must be in attendance at all times during Centre competitions.
2. You are required to be a parent or guardian helper at Centre competition at least every fortnight.
3. You are required to participate in the setting up and putting away of equipment prior to and following Centre competition, when scheduled to do so.

Key Assistants coordinate/control the running of a track or field event to ensure their smooth operation. This may be as a track starter/timekeeper or a coordinator at a jump or throw event.

Age Managers are parents/guardians who volunteer to oversee their assigned age group each week, accompanying the athletes during competition and providing assistance and support to their athletes. They also check and validate their athlete's results from recorded information on the Centre's computer system.
